

ABM IMPACT MEETINGS THURSDAY

Langdon, ND - Six different workshops, all dealing with impacts expected from the closure of the Missile Site Radar (MSR) portion of the Army's antiballistic missile system at Nekoma, ND, will be in session here Thursday.

The workshops will be a part of an Economic Adjustment Committee Team visit planned to start at 8 am at the Cavalier County Courthouse in Langdon.

Workshops, which will follow a registration and orientation period, include: Economic development, housing and community development, property and facility reuse, education, Small Business Administration, and social services and manpower.

Formal presentation of the preliminary base reuse plan will be given at 11 am, and a report from the workshops will follow an afternoon of study at 3:30 pm.

Economic Adjustment Team members and representatives of a number of federal and state agencies participate in the workshops, which have been designed to provide an opportunity for people of the impact area to voice their concerns.
